❖ **The Church Building Reopened and Online Worship**

- 1. From the last Lord's Day (June 7th), anyone who wanted to join the worship in the church building (onsite worship) attended the worship.** We give thanks to God who led us thus far. For a while from now on, our Lord's Day Worships will be held in the sanctuary as well as at home online.
- 2. Please check your health condition,** if you feel fever or chills, have cough, have underlying medical condition, then please worship God at your home for the safety of the whole Zion members.
- 3. Additionally, please understand that nowadays only Zion family can attend onsite worship.**
- If you are hard or uncomfortable to attend the onsite worship service, then please **"never"** be pressed on you rather stay at home and worship via YouTube as we all did so far.
- 5. The way to Entering and Exiting**
 - Checking body-temperature before & after worship/ b. For EM members, please exit the sanctuary through the front door beside the choir seats/ c. KM members, exit from back.
- The preparation of the church
 - Necessary Personal Hygiene Kits** (Face Mask, Hand Sanitizer) Prepared/ b. **The disinfection of the building** done before every worship service on Lord's Day/ c. The tool to check the body temperature (**infrared thermometer**) prepared and used **before each worship service/ d. The seats set** in consideration of social distance
