I pray that God, who gave us Word for evaluating our interests on the sermon on the last Lord's Day, would continue to care us and guides us to be balanced between our worldly interests and the kingdom of God as well as to remember our new qualification, in Christ, to have interest in the kingdom of God. I also pray that God would let us rely on Jesus Christ in order to embrace Zion family in our prayer and continually pursue the life as Christians should be.

'Zion Summer School 2020' would be prepared and proceeded online based on the decision of the board of trustees and the director. The period would be July 6th (M)~August 6th (Th) for 5 weeks (Monday~Thursday each week). For the details, please refer to Summer School section on our church website. Please pray for the preparation and precession of this biblically-right outreach program.

Because the church building reopened to our congregation, the session made a decision that **the church cleaning by cell groups is to be resumed as usual from the next Lord's Day (June 28th)** so that the sanctuary, fellowship room, and restroom might be cleansed and ready for accepting our congregation. Please understand and cooperate with this plan as well as pray for the stable reopen of our worship place.

In continuity, for parents of the students in Zion, please guide and encourage your children to attend the online Bible Study for elementary, youth, and young adult, with prayer. The possibility of the meeting of elementary and youth will be reevaluated in 2 weeks. Please pray for this.

❖ The Church Building Reopened and Online Worship

1. **From June 7th (LD), anyone who wanted to join the worship in the church building (onsite worship) have been attending the worship.** We give thanks to God who led us thus far. **For a while** from now on, our Lord's Day Worships will be held in the sanctuary **as well as** at home online. Therefore, as continually mentioned, if you are hard or uncomfortable to attend the onsite worship service, then please "**never**" be burdened with attending worship place(sanctuary), rather stay at home and worship via YouTube as we all have done so far.
2. **Please check your health condition**, if you feel fever or chills, have cough, have underlying medical condition, then please worship God at your home for the safety of the whole Zion members.
3. Additionally, **please understand that nowadays only Zion family can attend onsite worship.**
4. **The way to Entering and Exiting**
 - a. Checking body-temperature before & after worship/ **b. For EM members, please exit the sanctuary through the front door beside the choir seats/** c. KM members, exit from back.
5. The preparation of the church
 - a. **Necessary Personal Hygiene Kits** (Face Mask, Hand Sanitizer) Prepared/ b. **The disinfection of the building** done before every worship service on Lord's Day/ c. The tool to check the body temperature (**infrared thermometer**) prepared and used **before each worship service/ d. The seats set** in consideration of social distance
